COMING SOON TO CORONADO HEIGHTS PARK



Thanks to you and 170-plus other Friends of Coronado Heights we now have the funding for renovations to the castle and restroom building. Your gift, added to a \$90,000 grant from the Kansas Historic Preservation Trust Fund, make it possible for us to:

- Replace the observation deck in the castle
- Reuse and/or replace the castle support timbers
- Make each building accessible for visitors with mobility difficulties
- Make other needed repairs to each building

We are now going through the final architectural plans and contractor selection process. The actual start of construction will be announced soon.

CORONADO HEIGHTS WILL REMAIN OPEN THROUGH MOST OF THE BUILDING RENOVATION PHASE OF THE PROJECT

Now on to Phase Two—restoration of the original WPA drainage system to curb erosion and the installation of a more permanent asphalt paved road. Our goal is \$65,000.
